# TASS Transformation



- TASS organizations are being designed with flexibility to conduct ADT Programs to support future wartime operations and ARNG Force deployments
- TASS Full-time facilities and DL capabilities will be maximized
- Regional TASS missions will gravitate to TASS Centers of Excellence that have the ability to compress or accelerate programs to meet ***Force Readiness*** demands

***GOAL is Force Readiness***



# TASS Transformation



- Enhance Responsiveness of RC training base
- Develop a funding program with flexibility to adjust course delivery based on readiness demand
- TRAP without limits – ADT or IDT delivery combinations based on field demand
- IDT phased conversion to DL/ADT
- Realign TASS mission lanes to match force structure
- Create multi-component command structure to deliver ADT institutional training at consolidated Centers of Excellence



# Transformation Enablers



- Adjustment to the Institutional Training POM
- Fund all course phases (IDT or ADT) in TRIT for all Reclassification Programs
- Fund all course phases (IDT or ADT) in TRPD for all OES/NCOES/WOES Programs
- Establish critical linkage between TRNM and TRNC to TRIT and TRPD



# Transformation Enablers



- ADT Programs
  - Reclassification based on **Readiness** demands
  - NCOES based on unit deployment cycle
    - all CMF consolidated
- *Maximize use of RC training areas and facilities*
  - *Exploit Regional Advantages*
  - *Exploit Full-time school houses*
  - *Leverage DL as an IDT Phased Strategy*



# Concept of Transformation



In order to meet regional **Readiness** demands, RTIs and USAR TASS organizations need to be missioned to support predominant force structure with in the region

**Major Training Centers** will establish command and control nodes multi-component TASS assets co-located for training, resource, and demographic efficiencies

**Minor Training Centers** will be established leveraging historic TASS school houses success.

Historically successful training centers will be established as Centers of Excellence (COE)

# TASS Advisory Council (TAC)



- Currently under development
- The purpose of the TAC is to provide information and recommendations dealing with individual training to the PORTAC
- The TACs will be set up on a Regional Basis within the PORTAC



# TASS Advisory Council



- The first meeting is proposed for October and will be followed by several other regional meetings
- Transformation will be based on demographic and geographic densities of states and units after UA transformations
- The objective is to have a set of individuals that have an understanding of TASS (AC, USAR, and NGB) and modify existing NGB structure to increase efficiencies and sharpen the focus of each training site
  - State Quota Source Managers
  - RTIs
  - NCOAs
  - RTS-Ms



# TASS Subject Matter Experts



- Currently under development
- The objective is to have a set of individuals that are proficient within each Career Management Field
- Complete and thorough understanding of
  - All POI's, past, present, and future
  - Where the CMF is heading
  - How the current trends are impacting training
- Experts in the field with NGB support



# Course Writers/Developers



- Establish a pool of Subject Matter Experts (SME), in coordination with DCG ARNG HQ TRADOC, to assist the TRADOC Proponent Schools in the conversion of existing courseware (RC3 or AC) to TATS-C
- At the present time there is not an identified pool of ARNG SME's to fulfill this task
- The ARNG is currently tasked to teach the following CMF's: 11, 13, 14, 15 and 21
  - Additionally, the ARNG RTS-M's provides training in CMF 63
- The ARNG is soliciting support from the Title XI community in the identification process of qualified personnel within your ARNG Training Battalions and the ARNG/USAR Maintenance Battalion structure



# Title 11 Funding



- Each state receives \$4500 per Title 11 Soldier per year
- The funding goes to each state in MDEP TFNC and OMNG (2065)
- The comments in the FAD state the money is for TXI support
- The money is delivered in the first quarter of each year to each state
